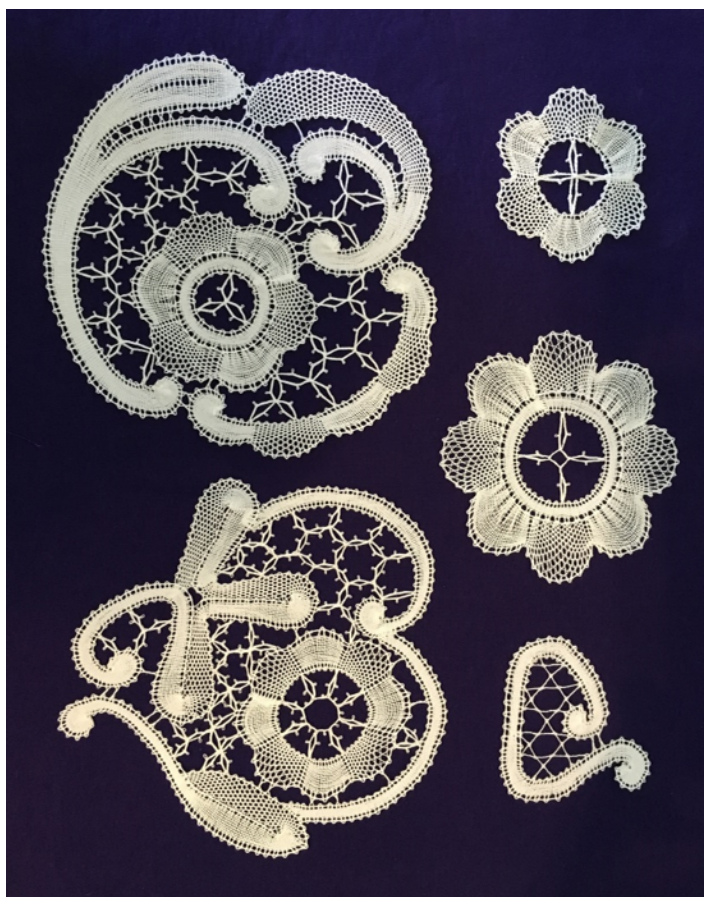

Bruges Lace – Beginning and Continuing

This class is designed for those wishing to explore (beginning) and perfecting (continuing) traditional Bruges lace. Lace students will learn the basic tape, plaits and picots, several types of flowers, leaves, and the scroll. Continuing students will learn how to navigate the fillings and some additional Bruges techniques. Students will work at their own pace with patterns provided or may bring patterns to discuss and explore possible working solutions. Come learn some new tricks to add to your lacemaking skills.

Elizabeth Peterson is from Salt Lake City, UT, and started making lace in 1985 and teaching in 1996. She teaches several types of lace weekly and has taught lace at IOLI Convention and Winter Lace Conferences. She believes lacemaking is fun and challenging and a great way to spend your time.
